

PORCELAIN SINK CARE AND MAINTENANCE



Porcelain sinks are durable, convenient, and affordable, but need routine cleaning to keep them looking pristine.

Never use scouring powders, vinegar, or steel wool as they can damage the porcelain finish.

For regular cleaning, use liquid dishwashing soap and hot water with a soft rag or sponge to scrub the sink. Then, rinse with water.

For a deeper clean, combine warm water, $\frac{1}{4}$ cup baking soda, and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup ammonia in a bucket. Soak a soft sponge in the solution, then scrub the sink clean and rinse well.

For added shine, rub a small amount of lemon oil on the porcelain sink. This will also act as a protective coating to help repel soap scum and dirt.
